


REPTON AL BARSHA EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY BOOKLET

Sign Up

The sign ups for internal extra-curricular activities are done via the School Cloud portal.

If you wish for your child to take part in an externally paid club please contact the providers directly (contact details below in booklet).

The School Cloud portal will open on Monday 4th September at 4:00pm and will close on Wednesday 6th September at 4:00pm.

Junior and Senior pupils will be able to select a maximum of two activities from the applicable after school activity list. This will allow more pupils to have access to internal ASA clubs. Before School Activities, however, will remain unlimited.

There will be two separate school cloud booking headings:

Before School Activities - Sports and specific Creative Arts clubs - unlimited number of clubs. After School Activities - Enrichment and Academic - maximum of two activities.

You will also be given the option to nominate a second and third preference of activity for a specific day, if you wish, to ensure your child secures a spot on that day. Your choice will be confirmed by the close of day on Friday 8th September.



Club Pick Up

Pick up for internal clubs (ASAs) will usually be from each pupil's normal year group exit. The teacher in charge of the club will dismiss your child. If you are unsure on where to collect your child please contact the teacher in charge of the club directly. For external club collections, please liase with the provider directly.

Pupils with siblings:

If a pupil in the foundation school has chosen an activity from 230pm-3.15pm/230-3.30pm and has an older sibling within the school, the older sibling will be dismissed at the end of the school day (3:30pm) and meet their younger sibling at the FS reception. This ensures that all siblings are collected from the same area.

If a Year 1 - 10 pupil is doing an activity after school, the younger sibling is to be picked up at their normal dismissal time.




