General rules pertaining to uniform:

- All items of uniform must be clearly labelled with the owner's name in either indelible pen or, preferably, by means of sewn in name labels
- School hats/caps must be removed upon entering the buildings
- Shirts should be tucked in at all times with ties and collars properly fastened
- Pupils wearing school uniform are expected to do so correctly when travelling between home and school

School Shoes:

The term 'regulation footwear' is defined as practical black shoes designed specifically with school wear in mind. The shoe should be fastened with laces or velcro or can be slip on. Ballet pumps or trainer-type shoes are not permitted. Shoes with any type of logos or branding on them are not permitted

Children who do not attend school in the correct school shoes, the incident will be logged as a B1 on iSAMS for recording purposes..

Hair:

Hair should be neat and tidy at all times. Hair longer than collar length must be tied back with a white, navy or black bobble or ribbon.

Extreme styles such as (but not restricted to) 'steps', 'undershaves', etc. are not permitted. Artificial colouring and/or hair products that detract from the natural and smart appearance of the hair are not permitted. For any children who have artificial colouring in their hair, parents will be informed and be asked to return the hair to its natural colour within 48-hours or they will be unable to return to class and will complete their learning at school, but in isolation. For any children who are spoken to about their hair style/colour, the incident will be logged as a B1 on iSAMS for recording purposes.

The final decision regarding suitability the of a hairstyle lies with the SLT team and parents may be contacted in the first instance for the student to be collected from school to adjust their hairstyle before being permitted to return to school.

Make-up and Nails:

Make-up and nail polish or nail extensions, like gels or acrylics, are not permitted in the Junior or Senior School. Nails should be kept to an appropriate length and if a student comes to school wearing nail polish, they will be asked by their tutor or Head of Year to visit the school clinic who will phone home and inform the parents that it will be removed with nail polish remover.

If a student comes to school with make-up or nail extensions, like gels or acrylics, which cannot be removed with nail varnish remover, parents will be contacted in the first instance for the student to be collected from school to minimise risk until the extensions are removed. The final decision regarding the suitability of make-up and nails lies with the SLT. For any children who have inappropriate nail styles, the incident will be logged as a B1 on iSAMS for recording purposes.

Jewellery:

In the interest of health and safety, **no jewellery** should be worn other than a standard analogue or digital watch. Smart watches are not permitted in the Junior School at Repton Al Barsha. However, girls with pierced ears may wear one pair of plain gold or silver studs in the lower lobe. No other earrings are permitted.
